- Posaune 2:** Enters from the first measure with a quarter note G3, followed by eighth notes A3-B3, and a triplet of eighth notes C4-B3-A3. It concludes with a half note G3.
- Posaune 3:** Enters from the first measure with a quarter note G3, followed by eighth notes A3-B3, and a triplet of eighth notes C4-B3-A3. It concludes with a half note G3.
- Bassposaune:** Enters from the first measure with a quarter note G2, followed by eighth notes A2-B2, and a triplet of eighth notes C3-B2-A2. It concludes with a half note G2.
- Tuba:** Enters from the first measure with a quarter note G2, followed by eighth notes A2-B2, and a triplet of eighth notes C3-B2-A2. It concludes with a half note G2.

Dynamic markings include *f* (forte) and accents. The score uses various note values including quarter, eighth, and triplet eighth notes, as well as rests.
